# ST. XAVIER'S SCHOOL

## AIMS & OBJECTIVES

St. Xavier's School is a private school established and conducted by the Catholic Diocese of Purnea for the Education of boys and girls upto High School Level. It is open to all without distinction of caste or creed.

The purpose of the Institution is to impart to its pupils a sound, Moral, intellectual and physical education. This is to train them to be useful and loyal citizens of India and to help them to become the agents needed for social changes in the country.

Realizing that education is an all round development of the pupils the Institution constantly endeavors to direct to this end all its curricular studies and co-curricular activities with special emphasis on discipline, formation of character and self reliance. Therefore "We are committed to lead the Children to a holistic development. The real inspiration is the Child JESUS who grew both in body and in wisdom, gaining favor with God and men (Lk.2:52). The intellectual growth must shape our character, behaviour, attitude and the values of life. Physical growth is the strength of our life.

The medium of instruction is English, but special emphasis is given to Hindi, the national language. Moral instruction, which is essential for character formation is imparted to all its pupils.

### FEATURES

1. St. Xavier's School is run by Catholic missionaries.
2. The School has its own infrastructure, a well set-up campus with enclosed playground and all the necessary facilities.
3. An English medium Co-Education School where Indian culture, manners and etiquette will hold importance.
4. Focus on holistic development of the Child.
5. Well trained and qualified teachers.



### EDUCATIONAL IDEALS

The School aims at the total development of the human person through liberal and scientific knowledge, through character building and physical training. Such an education inspires the students with :

1. A deep sense of religious and moral principles which help the student to be open to his fellow men and to God.
2. A sense of social responsibility and Commitment.
3. A desire for enlightened leadership committed to national service and development.
4. An appreciation of Indian and World Cultures.



## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Punctuality is a value at St. Xavier's School. All are to be punctual for the school activities and class. Students of Class V to X must be on the School premises by 07:15a.m, Class LKG and UKG by 8.00 am and class I to IV by 8.30 am.
2. At the sign of the first bell or music all the students must assemble in front of the School building.
3. Because of high standard of English required for the Central Board of Secondary Education, English will be spoken at all times on the School ground as further opportunity of practice. Students who are consistently breaking this rule, are liable to dismissal.
4. Private tuition is prohibited. Tutorial classes are conducted in the school for weaker students. Those who are found taking private tuition are liable to be dismissed.
5. Noble behaviour and respect towards all, are characteristics of a St. Xavier's student. On their way to and from school, all are expected to behave in decent manner. All must be tidy in dress and nobody should enter the school unless he/she wears the school uniform.
6. Shouting, whistling and running around are not allowed in the School building. It is strictly prohibited to throw anything at one another.
7. The School is yours. Look after it. Scratching or spoiling desks, writing with chalk or pencils on the walls, or in anyway damaging what belongs to others, is highly reprehensible behaviour.
8. Books other than text books, comics, magazines and newspapers are not allowed in the school.
9. Money should not be lent or borrowed or articles be given in exchange. The School is not responsible for things lost. It is not advisable to bring valuable articles to School.
10. Students are expected to join in various games and tournaments organized at the school level but they must be regular in attending once they have given their names.
11. Great care is taken to form the character of the pupils, to inspire them with love of religion and morality, to help them to become agents of needed social change in the country; to train them to be gentlemen and refined women and to acquire habits of cleanliness and order, to prepare them to be good and loyal citizens of India.
12. Students are requested not to enter the premises of the school with explosives like crackers, bombs, match boxes, lighters and sharp weapons. If any student is found with the above he/she will be dismissed from the school immediately without any prior information or notice.
13. Reports on general progress are given at the end of each term.
14. Pupils whose conduct is injurious to the moral tone of the school or incompatible with strict discipline are liable to be dismissed. In particular stealing and cheating will be dealt with very sternly.
15. Mobiles are banned at all times, Mobiles will be confiscated and will not be returned and a fine of Rs. 1000/- imposed.
16. The LANGUAGE of the school is ENGLISH. All are to converse in English at all times. Fine for not speaking in English is Rs 500/- and repeated violators will be dismissed.
17. Students must prepare their daily lessons and tasks at home, spend two hours and a half in home study before class and two hours after class. Parents and guardians are requested to enforce the adherence to this rule at home. Let them also insist on punctuality in their daily class.
18. Parents should inform the authorities if their child is suffering from any physical ailment, which makes it essential for the authorities to be aware of.
19. Students should not leave the School premises during class hours without the permission of the Principal/Vice-Principal.
20. Parents should not visit the class teacher or any other teacher without the permission of the principal.
21. All school fees must be paid between 11<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> of every month if paid on monthly basis else quarterly as indicated in the Almanac . A fine will be imposed for delay in paying. A student may be sent home without any prior notice for irregular payments of fees.
22. Students are not allowed to use Kajal, Bindi, Nail Polish and Mehendi etc. in school.
23. Hair must be neatly combed and tied on either side into two neat plaits using black hair band; if short it must be neatly combed and held back with a black hair band. Students must maintain neatness and cleanliness in their dress and work and keep their nails trimmed.
